Southern Gulf: Saqr Port Berth Extension - UAE

Saqr port berth extension project work will commence with effect from 25 Mar 2017 near RAK maritime city approaches.

Therefore, an exclusion zone will be established on the outer side of Saqr port breakwater. Flouting buoys and markers placed on below co-ordinates:

A. Buoy No. 1	25-58.96N	056-02.69E	Yellow	Flash yellow
B. Buoy No. 2	25-58.81N	056-02.64E	Yellow	Flash yellow
C. Buoy No. 3	25-58.66N	056-02.59E	Yellow	Flash yellow
D. Buoy No. 4	25-58.51N	056-02.54E	Yellow	Flash yellow
E. Buoy No. 5	25-58.40N	056-02.64E	Yellow	Flash yellow
F. Buoy No. 6	25-58.34N	056-02.76E	Yellow	Flash yellow

All movements should be co-ordinated with Mina Saqr / RAK Maritime City Port Control.

All mariners are requested to keep clear of the exclusion zone, proceed with minimum speed, navigate with caution around the area and maintain constant listening watch on VHF Channel 69/14.
