#### **Southern Gulf: Saqr Port – Dive Survey on RAKGAS Pipeline Activities**

BA Chart: 3174, 2888, 2837, 2858

A dive survey team will be conducting diving operations during the day within Saqr Port limits and adjacent waters as per the following RAKGAS schedule:

Dive survey around the suspected leak location on the Saleh Pipeline (in the vicinity of RAK Maritime City approach channel):

13 May 18                                  Lat 25-58.250N                  Long 055-59.302E

Dive survey of Single Point Mooring Bouy (SPM):

14 May 18 to 15 May 18                  Lat 25-58.260N                  Long 055-56.110E

Dive survey an old anchor located on Oil Export Pipeline (in the vicinity of RAK Maritime City approach channel):

14 May 18 to 15 May 18                  Lat 25-57.563N                  Long 055-59.833E

Divers will operate from the Crew boat 'SLS LION'. A 150-metre exclusion zone will be in place around SLS LION with a listening watch on VHF channels 16 and 69.

Mariners are further advised to navigate with extreme caution in the vicinity.
