Southern Gulf: Seismic Survey Operations – Approaches to Jebel Dhanna/Ruwais Ports

BA Charts: 2889, 3179

ADNOC conducting Seismic Survey operations at approaches to Jebel Dhanna and Ruwais Ports in an area bounded by the following co-ordinates:

- A. 24°38.750' N 052°39.020' E
- B. 24°44.880' N 052°58.260' E

All Vessels calling to Jebel Dhanna and Ruwais Ports are requested to transit the shipping route which has the following co-ordinates within the passage of 1000 m, which is 500 m on either side from the centre line of recommended route:

- A. 24°47.740 N 052°54.920 E
- B. 24°47.340 N 052°55.320 E
- C. 24°46.090 N 052°53.140 E
- D. 24°45.610 N 052°53.430 E
- E. 24°45.060 N 052°43.520 E
- F. 24°44.570 N 052°43.770 E
- G. 24°43.840 N 052°42.290 E
- H. 24°43.670 N 052°42.850 E
- I. 24°40.530 N 052°41.770 E
- J. 24°40.300 N 052°42.310 E
- K. 24°37.820 N 052°38.280 E
- L. 24°37.370 N 052°38.600 E

All ships need to proceed at safe speed with continuous listing watch on VHF channels 9, 16 and 21, all movement shall be coordinated with VTIS and do not drop anchor at these locations.

VTIS shall update all ships on arrival to ensure safe operations.
