Southern Gulf: UAE- Water Depths of Inner Channels of Jebel Dhanna Ruwais Port modified

Effective 01 NOV 18, the minimum water depth of the inner channels of Jebel Dhanna Ruwais Port has been modified to read as per below.

Vessels drawing draft of more than 14 meters, arriving and departing Jebel Dhanna Ruwais Port, shall submit their UKC/Draft Calculations to the Harbor Master's office prior to transiting.
