Central Gulf: Floating hose tow from Al Shaheen Field to Mesaieed – Offshore Qatar

MV Pacific Papillion will be towing 400 m floating hose string from Al Shaheen Field 26-34.800N, 052-01.800E to Mesaieed 24-57.200N, 051-35.800E between 2 to 5 DEC 18. The tow activity will be monitored by vessel MV Pacific Petrel.

During the towing, the two vessels will be restricted in their ability to manoeuvre. Mariners are requested to keep clear and exercise extreme caution when transiting this area.
