#### **Southern Gulf: Dubai – Muscat Offshore Sailing Race.**

20 sailing boats (27 to 50 feet in length) conducting an offshore race start on 240900 to 290500 UTC FEB 24 from Dubai 25-11.24N, 055-12.28E along the coast of the UAE to the Musandam and continue to Muscat 23-35.18N, 058-36.64E.

Another race will start on 290900 UTC FEB 24 to 021600 UTC MAR 24 From Muscat 23-35.18N, 058-36.64E to Khasab 26-12.76N, 056-15.04E.

Boats will return to Dubai Between 01 and 05 MAR 24 using the same route.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution and maintain listening watch on channel 16.
