Pipe laying operations by “DLB-750” & Associated crafts, from Arzanah island to BH-03 in Bu Haseer field is in progress on the following routes:

Start Point	24-59.59N	052-57.25E
IP-2	25-00.49N	052-52.73E
TP-12	24-50.57N	052-41.44E
End Point	24-47.13N	052-34.13E

“DLB 750” is connected to the anchors, by mooring wires, extended up to 1500 m, from the barge.

Mariners are requested to navigate with caution and maintain a listening watch on channel 16 & 23.
