The following buoys are temporarily re-located in new locations for the purpose of dredging operation:

No.1	24-24.62N	052-36.60E
No.3	24-23.93N	052-37.62E
No.5	24-23.46N	052-38.42E
No.7	24-22.60N	052-39.37E

Buoy No.5A deployed temporarily at position 24-23.31N, 052-38.64E and buoy N-Yas removed from position 24-22.57N, 052-39.355E.

Additionally, Turbidity Monitoring Buoys (TB1, TB2, TB ref) are temporarily deployed at the following locations:

TB 1	24-19.20N	052-42.78E
TB 2	24-20.91N	052-39.52E
TB ref	24-25.78N	052-36.34E

Yas Channel will be closed till further notice. Mariners are advised to exercise extra caution while transiting through the area and keep a sharp lookout for crossing traffic & to maintain constant listening watch on Ch 21/09 with the Port Control/VTIS.
